# The 15th Anniversary Public Symposium Call for papers

November 18th (Thursday), 19th (Friday), 2021 Venue: Online (live format)

## 1. Aim of the Meeting:

Through the gathering of specialists in the field of OLED science and technology for thorough discussion and debate, the 33rd Meeting of the Japan OLED Forum aims to advance the further development of the science, applied research, and practical use of OLEDs. This Meeting aims to build a common base for OLED-related science and technology while at the same time educating talented researchers and engineers through presentation and discussion of recent research and developments regarding OLEDs, create a common venue for industrial and academic cooperation through nationwide participation, and encourage the research development and business development of OLED displays and lighting by inspiring and guiding its participants toward realizing the future of OLEDs. With these aims in mind, presentations and in-depth discussions will be held regarding the fundamental research of OLEDs and the development of high-value OLED products. Please actively participate in and contribute to this Meeting.

This time, a commemorative public symposium will be held at the same time to commemorate the 15th anniversary of the Japan OLED Forum. At this symposium, leading experts in academic societies and industry will give lectures on cutting-edge science and technology related to organic EL. Even non-members can participate in this symposium free of charge.

### 8.4 Manuscript

Please submit a 2 page A4 version manuscript (including figures and tables) as a PDF file. If a dissertation is accepted, the manuscript will be offset-printed (monochrome) as it is, and a transcript will be created. For details, please follow the instructions given in the "Template Transcript Template" described on the website. Manuscripts and lectures will be in Japanese in principle. In addition, the abstract part of the manuscript will be published on the web at the same time as the program is released (after October 14th (Thursday)), and the entire manuscript will be published on the web for one month from Thursday, November 18.

#### **8.5** Selection of abstracts

The Forum adopts a peer review system for selecting abstracts based on the following criteria. If the content of an abstract is not in accordance with the purpose of the Forum, it might not be selected.

- ①Originality of the thesis is not required.
- ②Abstract content shall be able to withstand discussion at the Forum and be reproducible.
- ③ Based on the review, abstracts will be selected as either general oral presentations or short oral presentations or rejected. Abstracts can be submitted with a preference for short oral presentations. Both the general and short oral presentations will be part of the poster discussion.

#### 8.6 Outstanding Presentation Award

The Japan OLED Forum Outstanding Presentation Award is given to the member who displays excellence in the general presentations during the Meetings in autumn and spring. The award and a research scholarship (¥200,000) are presented to the best speaker under 35 years of age. Please see the Awards page for details.

- ①An automatic reply will be sent by email after registration is received. In the case that no reply is received after registration, please inquire at the contact address below.
- ② Notification of acceptance of the dissertation will be sent by e-mail by Wednesday October 13.
- 3 The total scheduled time for general oral presentations is 20 minutes per



session (presentation: 15 min; questions and answers: 5 min) and for short oral presentations is 5 minutes (no question time). However, this schedule might change depending the number of submissions.

①Speakers should also register for the Meeting in the same manner as non-speakers.

## 9. Handling of information

### 9.1 Handling of abstracts

- ①The information described in the abstract is assumed to be open to the public when the books of abstracts are distributed.
- ②The copyright to work appearing in the abstract will belong to both the Forum and the author.
- ③ The author bears responsibility for the content of the abstract and the presentation registration form.
- ④ Changes to abstracts after the submission deadline and withdrawal of presentations is not permitted.

### 9.2 Handling of information inside the meeting venue

- ①Audio recording, video recording, and photography inside the meeting venue is strictly prohibited. \* Please note that personal recordings and recordings cannot be completely prevented when held online.
- ② The contents of the presentations, question and answer sessions, and discussions are not recorded by the host and cannot be used as evidence in determining intellectual property rights. Participants are allowed to speak freely, and a lively discussion is expected.

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
