1. Aim of the Meeting:

Through the gathering of specialists in the field of OLED science and technology for thorough discussion and debate, the 35th Meeting of the Japan OLED Forum aims to advance the further development of the science, applied research, and practical use of OLEDs. This Meeting aims to build a common base for OLED-related science and technology while at the same time educating talented researchers and engineers through presentation and discussion of recent research and developments regarding OLEDs, create a common venue for industrial and academic cooperation through nationwide participation, and encourage the research development and business development of OLED displays and lighting by inspiring and guiding its participants toward realizing the future of OLEDs. With these aims in mind, presentations and in-depth discussions will be held regarding the fundamental research of OLEDs and the development of high-value OLED products. In addition, the 35th Annual Meeting will have a student oral presentation slot on a trial basis to provide educational support for students who wish to pursue this field. Please actively participate in and contribute to this Meeting.

7. Registration

① Participants (presenters, audience members) must be regular members of the Society or student members. If you are not a member, please follow the “Member Registration” on the homepage of the Society to complete the membership registration procedure.

② Please apply for participation from the "35th regular meeting application form" described on the homepage, we will automatically reply to the reception by e-mail. If you do not receive a reply, please contact us at the end. Registration opens on Tuesday, October 18. The application deadline is Monday, November 14.

③ The fee for regular members is 3,000 yen (tax-exempt) and free for student members. (The same fee applies if the event is changed to an online event.)

*Note: No cancellations will be accepted after payment has been completed. Please note that we will not be able to refund the participation fee paid.

④ Participants are requested to agree to the following before coming to the event.

- ・ We will take your temperature at the registration desk and those with a temperature of 37.5°C or higher will not be allowed to enter.
- ・ We will ask you to disinfect your hands and wear a mask at the registration desk.
- ・ We also ask that those who are not in good physical condition, those who have not been sick for a certain period of time since the onset of the new coronavirus, and those who have been in close contact with the virus for a certain period of time are not allowed to participate.

8. Submission outline for general presentations

8.1 Submission requirements: Contributors must be regular members or student members of the Forum.

8.2 Student Oral Presentations (on a trial basis)

At the 35th Annual Meeting, we will offer oral presentations by students on a trial basis to provide educational support for students who wish to pursue this field of research. Through oral presentations, Q&A sessions, and poster discussions, we hope that students will reconfirm their own research positions and increase their motivation by organizing the background, objectives, results, and issues of their research from an educational perspective.

8.5 Manuscript

Please submit a 2 page A4 version manuscript (including figures and tables) as a PDF file. If a dissertation is accepted, the manuscript will open to members via the web. For details, please follow the instructions given in the "Template Transcript Template" described on the website. Manuscripts and lectures will be in Japanese in principle. In addition, the abstract part of the manuscript will be published on the web at the same time as the program is released (after Tuesday, October 18), and the entire manuscript will be published on the web for one month from Thursday, November 17 .

8.6 Selection of abstracts

The Forum adopts a peer review system for selecting abstracts based on the following criteria. If the content of an abstract is not in accordance with the purpose of the Forum, it might not be selected.

①Originality of the thesis is not required.

②Abstract content shall be able to withstand discussion at the Forum and be reproducible.

③Based on the review, abstracts will be selected as either general oral presentations or short oral presentations or student oral presentations or rejected. Submissions specifying short oral presentations and student oral presentations will also be accepted. Both the general and short oral presentations and student oral presentations will be part of the poster discussion.

8.7 Outstanding Presentation Award

The Japan OLED Forum Outstanding Presentation Award is given to the member who displays excellence in the general presentations during the Meetings in autumn and spring. The award and a research scholarship (¥200,000) are presented to the best speaker under 35 years of age. Please see the Awards page for details.

②Notification of acceptance of the dissertation will be sent by e-mail by **Monday October 17**.

③Speakers should also register for the Meeting in the same manner as non-speakers.

9.1 Handling of abstracts

①Information in the Proceedings is deemed to be publicly available when it is

made available on the web.

②The copyright to work appearing in the abstract will belong to both the Forum and the author.

③The author bears responsibility for the content of the abstract and the presentation registration form.

④Changes to abstracts after the submission deadline and withdrawal of presentations is not permitted.

9.2 Handling of information inside the meeting venue

①Audio recording, video recording, and photography inside the meeting venue is strictly prohibited.

②The contents of the presentations, question and answer sessions, and discussions are not recorded by the host and cannot be used as evidence in determining intellectual property rights. Participants are allowed to speak freely, and a lively discussion is expected.
