④Participants are requested to agree to the following before coming to the event.

8.1 Submission requirements: Contributors must be regular members or student members of the Forum.

8.2 Student Oral Presentations

At the 36th meeting, we will have a student oral presentation slot to provide educational support for students who wish to pursue this field of research. Through oral presentations, Q&A sessions, and poster discussions, we hope that students will reconfirm the position of their own research and increase their motivation by organizing the background, objectives, results, and issues of their research from an educational perspective..

8.5 Manuscript

Please submit a 2 page A4 version manuscript (including figures and tables) as a PDF file. If a dissertation is accepted, the manuscript will open to members via the web For details, please follow the instructions given in the "Template Transcript Template" described on the website. Manuscripts and lectures will be in Japanese in principle. In addition, the abstract part of the manuscript will be published on the web at the same time as the program is released (after Tuesday, May 23), and the entire manuscript will be published on the web for one month from Thursday, June 15.

8.6 Selection of abstracts

The Forum adopts a peer review system for selecting abstracts based on the following criteria. If the content of an abstract is not in accordance with the purpose of the Forum, it might not be selected.

①Originality of the thesis is not required.

②Abstract content shall be able to withstand discussion at the Forum and be reproducible.

③Based on the review, abstracts will be selected as either general oral presentations or short oral presentations or student oral presentations or rejected. Submissions specifying short oral presentations and student oral presentations will also be accepted. Both the general and short oral presentations and student oral presentations will be part of the poster discussion.

8.7 Outstanding Presentation Award

The Japan OLED Forum Outstanding Presentation Award is given to the member who displays excellence in the general presentations during the Meetings in autumn and spring. The award and a research scholarship (¥200,000) are presented to the best speaker under 35 years of age. In addition, the "Student Presentation Encouragement Award" will be given to the student who makes an outstanding presentation among the student oral presentations.
